Arrival Requirements & Veterinarian's Checklist

1. Horses are required to arrive at Canterbury Park between **9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 23, 2025**. Horses may arrive on Friday, August 23rd by making special arrangements with Jay Dailey. Call 507-340-4747 if you plan to arrive on August 23, 2025.
2. REQUIRED VACCINATIONS:
 - **EHV-1** – It is required that all yearlings have been vaccinated by a veterinarian with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine specific for EHV-1 not less than 14 days and not more than 180 days prior to date of entry. The vaccination date, brand name, serial number, and expiration date of vaccine must appear on the health certificate.
 - **INFLUENZA** – Not less than 14 days prior to arrival and not more than 180 days prior to the entry date. Vaccination dates must appear on the health certificate.
 - **STRANGLES** – Not less than 14 days prior to arrival and not more than 180 days prior to the entry date. Vaccination dates must appear on the health certificate.
3. SUGGESTED VACCINATIONS:
 - **Equine Western and Eastern Encephalitis virus and West Nile Virus**
 - **Rabies**
4. HEALTH CERTIFICATE:

NOTE: CVI AND COGGINS CERTIFICATES FOR EACH HORSE MUST BE EMAILED TO NICOLE BOENTGEN IN THE MRC OFFICE (Nicole.Boentgen@state.mn.us) BY 8AM on AUGUST 23, 2025. Nicole will collect, examine, and forward the information to the MRC Veterinarian's Office for final approval.

- Health Certificate (CVI) – within 5 days of arrival at Canterbury Park.
- Please have your veterinarian prepare this CAREFULLY as there are special requirements when sending a horse to Canterbury Park.
 - EHV-1
 - The vaccination date, brand name, serial number, and expiration date of vaccine must appear on the health certificate.
 - Strangles & Influenza
 - The vaccination date and brand name must be listed on the health certificate.
 - Other suggested vaccinations and dates should appear on the health certificate.
 - The specific temperature of each horse must be listed. “Normal” or Within Normal Limits” is not acceptable.
 - EIA (Coggins) must be included on the Health Certificate including:
 - Date issued
 - Lab issuing the EIA
 - Accession Number
 - This phrase must be included on each certificate:
“This horse was deemed healthy at the time of examination and does not originate from a premise with known infectious diseases within the past 30 days.”

It is the consignor's responsibility to ensure that all information is complete upon arrival at the Stable Gate. Arrivals with incomplete CVI's will not be allowed on the backside and it will be the Consignor's responsibility to contact a veterinarian to correct the CVI.

CONSIGNOR RULES & REMINDERS

CHECK-IN SCHEDULE

- Horses must be at Canterbury Park on Saturday, August 23rd, 2025, after 9:00 AM, but no later than 1:00 PM. Horses may be brought in on Friday, August 22nd, with the permission of Canterbury Park.

PARKING

- All trailers and campers must unload on the west side of the receiving barn and be moved off the backside and into the horsemen's lot as quickly as possible to avoid delays in getting horses off the trailers and into their stalls.

STALLING

- Stalling will be in the Receiving Barn and stalls will be assigned by Dailey Realty & Auction. Maps will be posted indicating the location of each Consignor and stall cards will be in place prior to your arrival.
- **ALL HORSES MUST BE IN THEIR STALLS BY 1:00 PM on Saturday, August 23rd, 2025**

IDENTIFICATION

- Identification of each horse will be done on Saturday, August 23, 2025. Time will be announced. You must be available to take your horse out of the stall during the identification process. Any horse not identified while the identifier is present will not be allowed in the sales ring. You will receive a hang tag for your horse's halter to use prior to the sale. Hip tags will be distributed the day of the sale, upon return of the hang tags.

SALES GROUNDS ADMISSION: It is required that all horses have:

1. An original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health certificate) **issued within five (5) days of arrival at Canterbury Park.**
*****NOTE; This is an important change!**
 2. A Coggins test dated within the past 12 months prior to August 24, 2025. The results for each horse must be clearly marked on the CVI and must be legible and accurate.
 3. Horses with a CVI originating from a state with recorded active cases of Equine Piroplasmiasis (EP) must have a negative test for Babesia (Theileria) equi and Babesia caballi taken within the past 12 months prior to arrival. Currently this includes only Texas, but trainers and owners are encouraged to check the Minnesota Racing Commission website (www.mrc.state.us) for additional states with an active status.
 4. It is required that all yearlings have been vaccinated by a veterinarian with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine specific for EHV-1. Not less than 14 days and not more than 4 months prior to date of entry. The specific vaccination date must appear on the health certificate.
 5. In addition to the EHV-1 Vaccination; **it is required that all horses be vaccinated against influenza and strangles. All vaccinations must be completed no less than 14 days before arrival.** Additionally, Dailey Realty & Auction reserves the right to mandate any vaccine(s) as a condition of admittance based on pandemic or outbreak.
- No horse will be allowed to enter the grounds unless a current, valid health certificate covering said horse is presented prior to unloading. Valid health certificates on all horses arriving at the Sale Grounds must be presented upon arrival or horses will not be permitted to unload.
 - **Consignors will receive a checklist to be shown to your veterinarian, in addition to a properly completed sample of a CVI. We will not have a sale veterinarian available to resolve issues at the Stable Gate. If your CVI is not properly completed, you will have to take Your yearlings to the isolation stalls and make arrangements for one of the Backside veterinarians to make it right. Dailey Realty and Auction will make things as clear as possible, but it is ultimately the consignor's responsibility to be certain that everything is in order and all rules are being followed.**

IMPORTANT HEALTH NOTICES:

- **Communicable and Infectious diseases:**
 - Horses known by the Exhibitor to have an infectious, communicable disease or known to have been exposed to an infectious, communicable disease may not be entered in the Sale. **Warts and Ringworm are considered communicable diseases.** A statement from a veterinarian that a horse is being treated for these diseases is not acceptable. All horses will be inspected by the Sale Veterinarian upon arrival. The Sale Veterinarian may order immediate removal from the premises of any horse with symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease.
- **Vaccinations:**
- All horses must be vaccinated against influenza, strangles and EHV-1. Additionally, Dailey Realty & Auction reserves the right to mandate any vaccine(s) as a condition of admittance based on pandemic or outbreak. Vaccinations and dates must be included on the Health Certificate. Horses not properly immunized will not be allowed on the Sales Grounds and will therefore, not be in the sale and all previous consignment fees will be forfeited.

MNTBS PAPERWORK REQUIREMENTS:

- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) and Coggins for each yearling consigned must be e-mailed to Jaydaileysells@gmail.com by Wednesday, August 20th, 2025. The CVI must have been issued within 5 days of arrival at Canterbury Park and a negative Coggins test certificate issued within the 12 months prior to August 24th, 2025. Dailey Realty & Auction will send all documents to the MRC veterinary staff for review.
- **ORIGINALS** must be filed with Dailey Realty & Auction immediately upon arrival at the Sales Grounds!
