Dear Friends:

Canterbury Park and Dailey Realty & Auction will be holding the 2025 Yearling Sale on Sunday, August 24th at Canterbury Park. The Sale will be managed by Jay and Willa Dailey, Dailey Realty and Auction Service, with Jay Dailey as the Sale Contact. The sale will be held in the Canterbury Park Expo Center and consignments will be stalled in the Receiving Barn.

The 2025 sale will be limited to Thoroughbreds, with MN-bred yearlings and weanlings preferred. Other than MN-bred TB yearlings and weanlings will be accepted. All hip numbers will be assigned by a random draw. MN-breds and other than MN-breds will be combined in the sale. We will not be selling groups based on where they were foaled, however, weanlings will see first followed by yearlings. We will be listing the State in the catalog. The stall cards and auction tote board will clearly indicate the foaling state and it will be communicated multiple times by the Pedigree Reader and Auctioneer.

Included in this mailing you will find all the paperwork necessary to consign your horses to the Sale. It is critical that all paperwork and payment be in the Sale Office by Noon on Friday, June 27th. Digital JCC must also be assigned to the Dailey Realty & Auction by this deadline. Incomplete consignments will not be accepted. Pedigrees will be sent to the Jockey Club for pedigree compilation at Noon on July 1st. Any changes in submissions must be communicated to the Sale Office no later than Noon on July 27th. Yearlings submitted for pedigrees are expected to be presented at the sale. By submitting your consignments to the Sale, you agree to abide by all the rules set forth and that your consignment fee is non-refundable.

A Preview will be held on Saturday, August 20th from 5:00 PM – 8:00 PM and again on August 24th from 10:00 AM until the time of the sale to allow potential buyers a chance to look at the horses up close. We ask that consignors be on hand to show their consignments. Horses must arrive on the Sale grounds between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM on Saturday, August 23rd.

We will be utilizing Canterbury Park's requirements for admission to the backside as our entrance requirements for the Sale. There are no exceptions to this admittance policy and horses that are turned away will not be in the sale and no refunds will be given. Full admission requirements are included in the Rules & Reminders.

It is required that all horses have:

1. An original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health certificate) issued within five (5) days of arrival at Canterbury Park. **NOTE THE CHANGE TO 5 DAYS!!**
2. A Coggins test dated within the past 12 months prior to August 24th, 2025. The results for each horse must be clearly marked on the CVI and must be legible and accurate.
3. Horses with a CVI originating from a state with recorded active cases of Equine Piroplasmiasis (EP) must have a negative test for Babesia (Theileria) equi and Babesia caballi taken within the past 12 months prior to arrival at the track. Currently this includes only Texas, but trainers and owners are encouraged to check the Minnesota Racing Commission website (www.mrc.state.us) for additional states with an active status.
4. It is required that all yearlings have been vaccinated by a veterinarian with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine specific for EHV-1 not less than 14 days and not more than 4 months prior to date of entry. The specific vaccination and vaccination date must appear on the health certificate.
5. It is required that all horses be vaccinated against influenza, strangles and EHV-1. All vaccinations must be completed no less than 14 days before arrival.

Additionally, the Sale Office reserves the right to mandate any vaccine(s) as a condition of admittance based on pandemic or outbreak.

No horse will be allowed to enter the grounds unless a current, valid health certificate covering said horse is presented prior to unloading. **All CVI and Coggins must be submitted to the Sale Office via email.** They will be forwarded to the State Vet's Office for review and accuracy. **This submission is due within 5 days of August 18th, 2025 (on flip side)** If you arrive at the State Gate without having submitted your paperwork by August 18th, 2024; you will have to take your yearlings to the isolation stalls and make arrangements for one of the Backside veterinarians to correct any issues.

The Sale Office will make things as clear as possible, but it is ultimately the consignor's responsibility to be certain that everything is in order and all rules are being followed. The health and safety of our yearlings, plus the 1,100 horses on the Canterbury Park Backside is our priority. The rules included in our paperwork apply to everyone and are non-negotiable. As a consignor, it is your responsibility to understand and adhere to each rule to ensure that your horses and all other horses consigned to this sale will be as safe and healthy as possible when they move to their new owners racing stables.

Please review Condition ELEVENTH and TWELFTH of the Conditions of Sale very carefully. Consignors will have new reporting requirements regarding the administration of medications. Purchasers are being given the option of having the yearlings tested, immediately following the sale and before they leave the Receiving Barn. Details are carefully explained in the Conditions of Sale and are in line with the actions being taken by major sale companies to ensure that our buyers are receiving the best possible product for their stable.
